- 8:45 AM - Arrive at Hotel Everest View for breakfast
- 9:15 AM - Depart from Syangboche and fly back to Lukla
- 9:30 AM - Continue the flight from Lukla back to Kathmandu
- 10:10 AM - Arrive Back in Kathmandu
